Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

WOF = Width of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

QST = Quarter Square Triangle

HST = Half Square Triangle

2 ½ yards WIDEBACK backing fabric of your choice Basic Sewing Supplies Batting (88" x 103")

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all pattern instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.


Fat Quarter

From (5) Fat Quarters cut:

- (1) 22" x 8" strip, subcut:
 - (1) 8" x 8" square, label A.

From the remaining strip, subcut:


- (2) 14" x 3 ½" strips, subcut:
 - (5) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.
- (1) 22" x 4 1/4" strip, subcut:
 - (2) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, label C.



From (6) Fat Quarters cut:

- (1) 8" x 16" rectangle, subcut:
 - (2) 8" x 8" squares, label A.
- (2) 14" X 4 1/4" strips, subcut:
 - (4) 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" squares, label C.
 - (2) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.
- (2) 14" x 3 ½" strips, subcut:
 - (8) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.






Woodland Melody

Cut (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips, subcut:

(72) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label E.

Cut (3) 4 ¼" x WOF strips, subcut:

- (20) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, label C.
- (8) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label E.



Cut (13) 3 ½" x WOF strips; place (7) strips aside for borders. From the remaining (6) strips, subcut:

(72) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label D.

Cut (3) 4 ¼" x WOF strips, subcut:

(20) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, label C.

(8) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label D.

Cut (4) 8" x WOF strips, subcut:

(20) 8" x 8" squares, label B.

Cut (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips; place aside for binding.



Forest Friends

Cut (9) 4 ½" x WOF strips, place (8) strips aside for borders. From the remaining (1) strip, subcut:

- (4) 4 1/4" x 4 1/4" squares, label C.
- (6) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.

Cut (1) 8" x WOF strip, subcut:

- (2) 8" x 8" squares, label A.
- (4) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.



Forest Floor

Cut (9) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, place (8) strips aside for borders. From the remaining (1) strip, subcut:

(5) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares, label F.

Place the remaining 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip with the other border strips.

Cut (1) 8" x WOF strips, subcut:

- (1) 8" x 8" square, label A.
- (2) 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" squares, label C.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints.

8-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

Place (2) squares RST. Draw (2) diagonal lines on the wrong side of one square. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn lines. Cut on the drawn lines as well as the horizontal and vertical centers to create (8) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to desired size.









BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Using the HST method, pair (1) A square with (1) B square. Trim to 3 ½" square. Make (160) total HST Units.

QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLES (QST)

2. Take all C squares and cut on both diagonals creating (4) triangles. Keep prints grouped together.





3. Take (1) print and (1) Woodland Melody triangle and sew together as shown.



4. Take the same print and (1) Cream triangle and sew together as shown.




5. Take the pieced triangle units and sew together as shown. QST Unit should measure 3 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished.




6. Repeat using all prints to make (80) total QST Units.

- 7. Lay out (4) D squares, (8) HSTs, (4) E squares, (5) F squares, and (4) QSTs as shown, ensuring that the HSTs, F squares, and QSTs are from the same print.
- 8. Piece together the blocks to make (5) rows then sew the rows together to complete a block. Block will measure 15 %" x 15 %" unfinished.



- 9. Repeat to make (20) Blocks.
- 10. Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, arrange the blocks in (5) rows of (4) blocks.





QUILT ASSEMBLY

11. Sew the blocks together and then sew the rows together to make the quilt center. Quilt center should measure 60 %" x 75 %" unfinished.

BORDER ASSEMBLY

Note: Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

- 12. Sew the (7) 3 ½" x WOF Cream strips end-to-end and subcut into (2) 66 ½" strips and (2) 75 ½" strips. Sew the (2) 75 ½" strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Then sew the (2) 66 ½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams towards the Wiltshire Shadow Cream fabric.
- 13. Sew the (8) 4 %" x WOF Forest Friends strips end-to-end and subcut into (2) 74 %" strips and (2) 81 %" strips. Sew the (2) 81 %" strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Then sew the (2) 74 %" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams towards the Forest Friends fabric.
- 14. Sew the (9) 3 ½" x WOF and 3 ½" x 24 ½" Forest Floor strips end-to-end and subcut into (2) 80 ½" strips and (2) 89 ½" strips. Sew the (2) 89 ½" strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Then sew the (2) 80 ½" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams towards the Forest Floor fabric.

Your quilt top should measure 80 ½" x 95 ½" unfinished.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Bind with the (10) Shadow Cream strips.
